Employed with New York City Department of Correction oppose the Board of Correction proposed measures to amend section 1-03 (OVERTIME for Correction Officers) and section 1-04 (OVER CROWDING) to the minimum standards for New York City Correction Facilities.

By amending section 1-03 (OVERTIME for Correction Officers) would have and adverse affect on the inmate population. It is imperative that correction officers acquire sufficient rest, which would allow them to be vigilant and alert when caring for inmates in their custody.

By amending section 1-04 (OVER CROWDING) would create crowded and dangerous conditions for the inmate population house in open dormitory. Additional inmates mean more potential for friction among prisoner such as stabbing and slashing. Surveillance by staff would become more difficult. These measures are unnecessary considering a reduction in the prison population.
